2 Requirements of the Final Paper

2.1 Present recent research and study achievements with a focused theme and factual content;

2.2 Combine theory with practice, preferably citing case studies and empirical study achievements;

2.3 The length of papers should be around 5000 Chinese or 8000 English words;

2.4 Submissions should include: title, author's name, contact information, abstract, keywords, text, acknowledgements and references.

2.5 Confidential technical information is not desired in the papers and the authors are responsible for any issues arising from such content in their paper.

Upon evaluation by a team of experts organized by the Conference Secretariat, the selected papers will be compiled into a Conference Proceedings and authors will be arranged to make presentation at the Conference.

3 Paper Submission Procedures

3.1 Paper abstracts (around 300 Chinese or 500 English words) are to be submitted in Microsoft Word format before 15 May, 2009. Abstracts can be sent to info@saq.org.cn.

3.2 An acknowledgement in E-mail will be sent to the author by the Conference Secretariat as confirmation. Please contact the Conference Secretariat for matters relating to paper confirmation.

3.3 The deadline for final paper submission is 15 August 2009. Please provide your biography (present post, social concurrent post, education background, academic degree, and other achievements) together with the paper in Microsoft Word format, and submit them to the Conference Secretariat by email to: info@saq.org.cn. The submitted papers will not be returned. Please maintain a copy of your submitted manuscript for your future reference.
